

Crown Pointe Academy has elected to give the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS) as a computer based test. All tests that fall under CMAS will be computerized. These test will cover Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies.

Also included are the Colorado Alternate Assessment (CoAlt) which cover English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies. This is administered to students with significant cognitive disabilities who are instructed and assessed on alternate achievement standards. A Student's IEP team makes the determination if a student qualifies for the alternate assessment following criteria provided by the Colorado Department of Education Exceptional Student Services Unit via the eligibility worksheet. This is the only group that may be excused from the computerized tests.

All school assessments and classroom tests are not included and will be up to the teacher as the best way to administer the test. READ Act assessments and ACCESS are not included in this policy.
