

Crown Pointe Academy has adopted the Colorado Charter School Institute Nutritional Beverage Policy.

Crown Pointe Academy is prohibited from permitting the sale of beverages, except as described in Colorado Charter School Institute's Rules for the Administration of Healthy Beverages and Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S. 22-30.5-517), which meets the minimum nutritional standards for beverages which are as follows:

For Elementary School:

- Bottled water (Any Size)
- Milk and 100% Juice (Up to 8 ounces)
- Fat-free or low-fat regular and flavored milk and nutritionally equivalent (per USDA) milk alternatives with up to 150 calories /8 ounces
- 100% juice with no added sweeteners, up to 120 calories/8 ounces, and at least 10% of the recommended daily value for three or more vitamins and minerals

For Middle School:

- Same as elementary schools except juice and milk may be sold in 10 ounce servings

These guidelines are to be enforced while students are in school and on school campuses during the regular and extended school day from any source, including but not limited to:

- School cafeterias;
- Vending machines;
- School stores; and
- Fund-raising activities conducted on school campuses.

"Extended school day" means the regular hours of operation for Crown Pointe Academy plus any time spent by students after such regular hours of operation for any purpose, including but not limited to participation in extracurricular activities or childcare programs.

These guidelines do not apply to school-related events where parents and other adults are part of an audience or are selling beverages as boosters during intermission, as well as immediately before or after an event. Examples of these events include school plays and band concerts.
