Crown Pointe Academy will act in accordance with state and federal law and the Charter Authorizer. Crown Pointe Academy shall provide age appropriate, developmentally-based drug, alcohol, and nicotine product education and prevention programs.

The drug, alcohol, and nicotine product education programs shall address the legal, social and health consequences of drug, alcohol, and nicotine use. It shall include special instruction as to the effects upon the human system, the emotional, psychological and social dangers of such use with emphasis on non-use by school-age children, and the illegal aspects of such use. The program also shall include information about effective techniques for resisting peer pressure to use illicit drugs or alcohol.

The curriculum, instructional materials and strategies used in this program shall be recommended by the Executive Director and approved by the Academy Board.
